



Construction Update: March 2-8, 2020 As of Friday, Feb. 28 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

EXTENDED: Work on the bridge pier in the median on I-25 has been extended to **Friday, March 6, 2020**. During this work, **northbound I-25 has the left lane closed near the I-25 University Bridge**. It will reopen to two lanes after this work is completed.

Work is continuing on the northbound I-25 on-ramp from westbound University Avenue, with this phase expected to last through about **March 13, 2020**. Both lanes of I-25 will be open at the ramp, with work taking place on the shoulder just north of westbound University Avenue.

CONTINUING: Southbound I-25: Two lanes of traffic are open, but traffic has shifted to the left north of the southbound I-25 off-ramp. *Motorists should watch for trucks turning in this area.* Traffic has also shifted left from the southbound I-25 off-ramp to University for storm drainage work and construction of the new southbound I-25 on-ramp.

University Avenue: Two lanes are open in each direction (eastbound and westbound), but the westbound lanes have been shifted to the south near I-25 to allow additional room for crews to work on bridge construction.

NOTE: *Motorists heading west on East University can use the driving lane to turn right and head north on Don Roser Drive while the right turn lane is blocked for ongoing work.*

COMING NEXT WEEK: On **Thursday, March 12**, the I-25 northbound loop ramp will be closed for **about 2 weeks**. Motorists will be able to access northbound I-25 via the ramp at Las Alturas Drive.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS.

Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.** but crews will be working a partial day on **Saturday, Feb. 29.**
