



Construction Update: April 6-12, 2020 As of Friday, April 3, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

TENTATIVE: Pending availability of materials, crews will **close the I-25 northbound on-ramp** sometime in the next several weeks and **re-open the I-25 northbound loop ramp** to provide access to northbound I-25 for eastbound traffic on University. A detour will be provided for westbound I-25 traffic. The on-ramp will be closed for about three weeks. **Confirmation and detour information will be provided in advance when this closure is confirmed.**

CONTINUING: The I-25 northbound loop ramp is **closed**. Motorists can access northbound I-25 by turning left at the traffic signal.

Northbound I-25: All lanes are open.

Southbound I-25: All lanes are open. Traffic near the southbound I-25 off-ramp should watch for trucks turning in the area.

University Avenue: All lanes are open.

NOTE: Motorists heading west on East University can use the driving lane to turn right and head north on Don Roser Drive while the right turn lane is blocked for ongoing work.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS.

Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.**
