



Construction Update: May 11-17, 2020
As of Friday, May 8, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

NEW: Late on Friday, May 8, the northbound I-25 on-ramp is scheduled to reopen. Work will shift to the south side of E. University Ave., with one lane of traffic in each direction (east and west) from Don Roser to the northbound I-25 off-ramp. This work is expected to last for about two weeks, through May 22, 2020.

CONTINUING: Southbound I-25: The righthand lane of southbound I-25 will be closed from north of University to the bridge during the daytime only, from 7 a.m.-5 p.m. through Friday, May 15, 2020 so crews can install storm drainage pipe.

The free righthand turn lane from the southbound I-25 off-ramp to westbound University Avenue is **PERMANENTLY CLOSED**. Access is provided at the traffic signal at the intersection of the ramp and University Ave.

Northbound I-25: The right lane is closed from Geothermal Drive to the northbound I-25 loop ramp. The I-25 off-ramp remains open.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS. Thank you for your patience during construction!
