



Construction Update: June 15-19, 2020
As of Friday, June 12, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

NEW: The new southbound I-25 on- and off-ramps at University Ave. are scheduled to be open towards the end of this week. The ramps will remain open while construction takes place on the Phase 1 (North) bridge, which is scheduled through mid-October 2020.

Crews will be installing a traffic signal at the intersection of University Ave. and Las Alturas Drive. Motorists should expect various short-term lane closures for this work all week and should use caution in this area.

CONTINUING: Two lanes of traffic are open in each direction on University Avenue, except the eastbound right lane is closed for a short distance to allow a right turn onto the southbound I-25 off-ramp until the new off-ramp opens.

The I-25 northbound loop ramp is open. I-25 northbound lanes are reduced to one lane to place loop ramp traffic in the right lane. North of the I-25 bridge, 2 thru lanes are open.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS.
