



Construction Update: Aug. 31-Sept. 6, 2020 As of Friday, August 28, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

NOTE: Crews will not be working on Friday, Sept. 4 or Monday, Sept. 7 in observance of the Labor Day Holiday. Barricades will remain in place for safety.

CONTINUING: Triviz Drive is closed from Arrowhead Drive to Stewart Street so crews can work on the south roundabout. Also closed are the direct connections to the New Mexico State University parking lots from I-25 and north Triviz Drive.

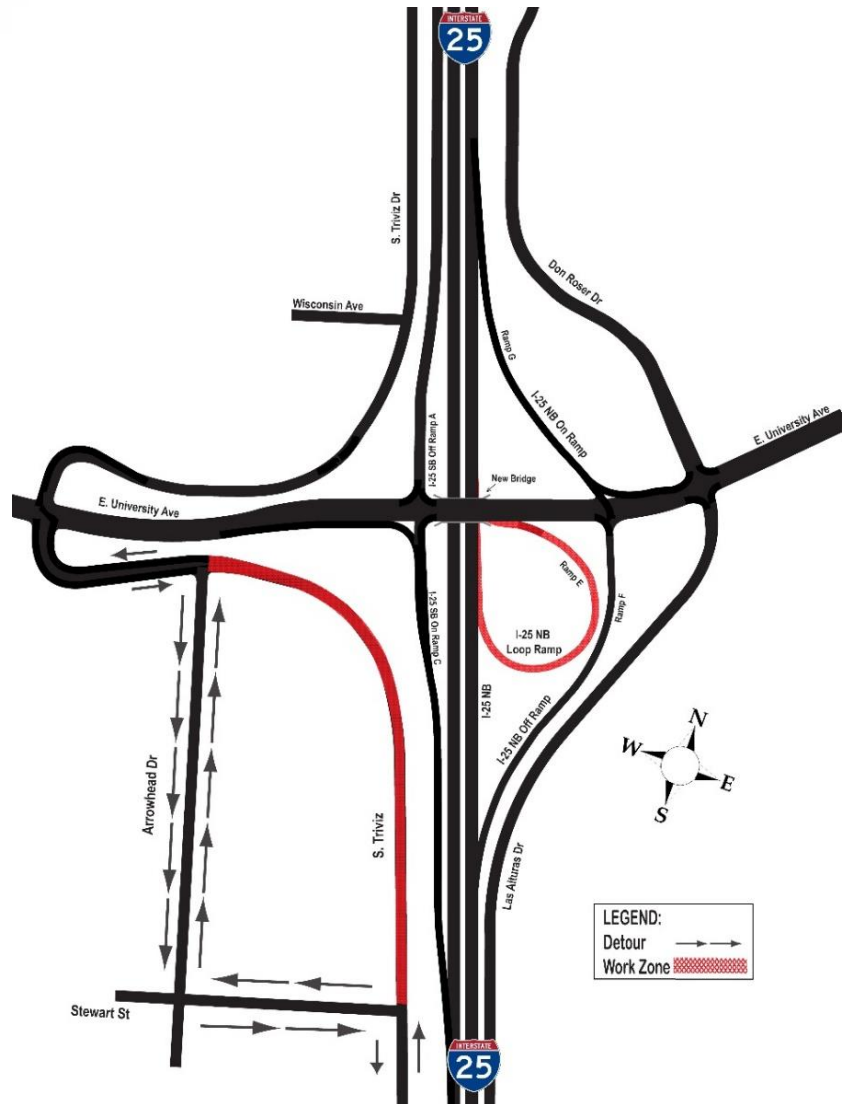
Motorists can use Stewart Street and Arrowhead Drive to access S. Triviz Drive, University Avenue and the parking lots during this closure.

This work is expected to last through **early to mid-October** if there are no unforeseen circumstances.

The northbound I-25 loop ramp is **CLOSED** until further notice. Motorists can access northbound I-25 from the on-ramp.

Two lanes of traffic are open in each direction on University Avenue between Triviz and Las Alturas.

The southbound I-25 on-ramp and off-ramp will remain open until Phase 1 of the bridge construction is completed, which is currently scheduled for early November.
