



Improving Safety and Traffic Flow

NEW: Crews will reopen the northbound I-25 loop ramp to traffic on Tuesday, Sept. 22, 2020. At the same time, access from eastbound University Avenue to northbound I-25 via the northbound I-25 on-ramp will be closed so crews can pave a portion of that intersection. **Westbound traffic will continue to have access to the northbound I-25 on-ramp. This work is expected to last 2-3 weeks, through early to mid-October.**

CONTINUING: Triviz Drive is closed from Arrowhead Drive to Stewart Street so crews can work on the south roundabout. Also closed are the direct connections to the New Mexico State University parking lots from I-25 and north Triviz Drive.

Motorists can use Stewart Street and Arrowhead Drive to access S. Triviz Drive, University Avenue and the parking lots during this closure.

This work is expected to last through **early to mid-October** if there are no unforeseen circumstances.

Two lanes of traffic are open in each direction on University Avenue between Triviz and Las Alturas.

The southbound I-25 on-ramp and off-ramp will remain open until Phase 1 of the bridge construction is completed, which is currently scheduled for mid-November.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS. Thank you for your patience during construction!
