



Construction Update: Oct. 5-11, 2020 As of Friday, Oct. 2, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

NEW: The right lane of Triviz Ave. is closed from Arrowhead to the University intersection.

CONTINUING: Eastbound traffic on University Ave. must use the I-25 northbound loop ramp to access northbound I-25 since crews are paving a portion of the intersection on University Ave. at the northbound I-25 on-ramp. Westbound traffic has access to the northbound I-25 on-ramp. The right lane of northbound I-25 is closed to allow use of the loop ramp. ***This work is expected to last through mid-October.***

South Triviz Drive is closed from Arrowhead Drive to Stewart Street so crews can work on the south roundabout. Also closed are the direct connections to the New Mexico State University parking lots from I-25 and north Triviz Drive. ***Motorists can use Stewart Street and Arrowhead Drive to access South Triviz Drive, University Avenue and the parking lots during this closure.*** This work is expected to last through **mid-October** if there are no unforeseen circumstances.

Two lanes of traffic are open in each direction on University Avenue between Triviz and Las Alturas.

The southbound I-25 on-ramp and off-ramp will remain open until Phase 1 of the bridge construction is completed, which is currently scheduled for mid-November.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS. Thank you for your patience during construction!
