



Construction Update: Jan. 11-17, 2021 As of Friday, January 8, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

NEW: On Tuesday, Jan. 12, 2021, crews are scheduled to reopen Triviz Drive between the University and Wisconsin intersection and close Triviz Drive from Arrowhead to University for about 3-4 weeks. Traffic will be detoured on East University to South Espina Street, then to Stewart Street. A reminder about this closure with a detour map will be sent on Monday, Jan. 11.

CONTINUING: The I-25 northbound loop ramp is closed for traffic safety. Both eastbound and westbound traffic on University Avenue can access northbound I-25 from the on-ramp at the traffic signal.

The right lane of Triviz Avenue is closed from Arrowhead to the University intersection through late January 2021. Two left lanes of traffic are open.

COMING LATER THIS MONTH: The southbound I-25 off-ramp will be closed for two weeks, with traffic detoured to I-10 and back to University Avenue. Closure and detour information will be provided in advance.

MOTORISTS SHOULD USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE OR EXPECT DELAYS, PARTICULARLY DURING MORNING AND AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS. *Thank you for your patience during construction!*

Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.** although crews may work longer hours or on Saturdays as needed.
