



Construction Update: September 13-19, 2021 As of Friday, September 10, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

ONGOING: The right lane of northbound I-25 is closed between the northbound I-25 off-ramp and the northbound I-25 loop ramp for reconstruction, which is scheduled to be completed this week.

NEW: Once the reconstruction of northbound I-25 is completed, crews will reconstruct a portion of southbound I-25 near University Ave. **The right lane of southbound I-25 will be closed for work on the shoulder for several weeks, beginning either this week or next week.**

Motorists traveling in these areas should expect delays.

ONGOING: Both eastbound and westbound lanes on University Ave will be closed occasionally for installation of landscaping, permanent signs and work on traffic signals. **One lane of traffic will remain open in each direction (eastbound and westbound) on University Ave during this work.**

There will also be occasional lane closures on both northbound and southbound I-25 for miscellaneous bridge work and paving. **One lane of traffic will remain open in each direction (northbound and southbound) on I-25 during this work.**

The I-25 loop ramp is open to eastbound traffic on University Ave and is the only way eastbound traffic can access northbound I-25. Westbound traffic on University Ave will continue to access northbound I-25 from the ramp at the traffic signal.

Access from University Ave to the southbound I-25 on-ramp is through the Triviz/University intersection and the new south roundabout. Detour signage is in place.

Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.**, although crews may work longer hours or on Saturdays as needed.
